



Transport Policy


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James Street Steel is committed to minimising the social and environmental impacts of transporting materials to and from our premises.

Transport is a necessary part of our operations, meeting stakeholders, delivery of raw materials, finished product and commuting employees. James Street recognises that these have a potential impact on the environment through vehicle emissions, fuel consumption and congestion. We are committed to minimising the environmental and social impacts along with costs impacts where practicable, through:

- Collaborating with our hauliers to ensure the transport of our material safely and reducing the number of loads needed for a job.
- Efficient planning of load and avoiding unnecessary traffic congestion with prearranged deliveries with sites.
- Rationalising material and customer deliveries to essential and bulk order wherever possible.
- Using GPS tracking on all our vehicles to facilitate “Just in Time” deliveries and avoid unnecessary traffic congestion with deliveries booked in at customer sites.
- Monitor and work with hauliers to ensure vehicles are maintained in a good condition and comply with all road traffic and statutory regulations.
- Ensuring that all company vehicles are maintained and serviced to ensure efficiency and minimise GHG emissions.
- Looking at alternatives when acquiring new company vehicles (i.e. Hybrid and electric vehicles).
- Promoting awareness of the transport policy with our stakeholders and employees.

This policy will be reviewed on a regular basis to incorporate new regulations, initiatives, available technologies, and best practice guidelines.
